Industrial unions - right of entry - recommendation made in respect of

RECOMMENDATION

As full settlement with Southern Printing Co., 26 Baile Road, Canning Vale, Western Australia and the Printing and Kindred Industries Union in C Nos 30012 of 1992 and 60037 of 1992 the following shall apply:

1. The Printing and Kindred Industries Union will withdraw their notification of dispute - C No. 30012 of 1992.
2. Southern Printing Co. will withdraw their application to vary the Graphic Arts Award, 1977 - C No. 60037 of 1992.
3. Provided that and only for as long as any employer in the State of Western Australia who is a respondent to the Award has a conscience before God and belongs to the fellowship known as  **the Brethren** , any right or function under the Award of a union or employer organisation to approach or communicate with such an employer shall be exercised only by the Industrial Registrar or Deputy Industrial Registrar of the Australian Industrial Relations Commission or Federal Inspectorate Officers.
4. Provided that and only for as long as any employer in the State of Western Australia who is a respondent to the Award has a conscience before God and belongs to the fellowship known as  **the Brethren** , where the Award requires such an employer to communicate with the union or employer organisation about any matter (including apprenticeship matters) then that employer may fulfil its obligation under the Award by notifying or communicating with the Industrial Registrar or Deputy Industrial Registrar.
